

The State of Louisiana Wants to Drop Medicaid Benefits, and We're Taking Them On



The Louisiana Nursing Home Association (LNHA) has selected sb2 inc. to represent the organization against the Louisiana Department of Health. The department recently <u>announced</u> it will be sending out a letter to 37,000 Medicaid recipients on July 1st to declare that they may be losing benefits due to a funding shortfall.
